## CALL FOR PAPERS

The Junior Research Group of the Consortium of Latin American Researchers in Germany (ADLAF) is organizing its seventh interdisciplinary conference for young scholars in cooperation with the Bavarian Academic Center for Latin America (BAYLAT) at the Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg (FAU) on **Friday, December 2, and Saturday, December 3, 2022.**

The Young Scholars Conference will be hosted as a hybrid event in Erlangen. It is aimed at master's students and doctoral candidates from all disciplines dealing with Latin America. It offers a forum to present current research projects, engage in interdisciplinary scientific dialogue, and build lasting networks. In addition, the conference aims to intensify ADLAF's work with young scholars. To facilitate a diverse exchange about current Latin American studies beyond individual disciplines or lines of research, the conference's theme is deliberately kept open.

Young scholars\* interested in presenting their research projects are invited to send an abstract of max. 2 pages (including personal details, the status of their research project, and a statement of preference for online or face-to-face participation) to [adlaf-nachwuchs@posteo.de](mailto:adlaf-nachwuchs@posteo.de) by **October 15, 2022.**

The submitted presentations will be grouped into thematic panels to allow for competent moderation by subject matter experts\* and substantive discussions. Presentations can be given in German, English, Spanish, or Portuguese.

There are no conference fees for participation. The ADLAF grants a subsidy for travel and accommodation costs to speakers living outside of Erlangen-Nürnberg.
